Fifth Metatarsal Fracture Surgery - AOFAS The base of the fifth metatarsal is divided into three fracture zones. Zone 1 fractures are avulsion or "chip" fractures that occur at the tip of the base of the fifth metatarsal. These fractures are typically treated without surgery using a cast, boot or hard-soled shoe. These fractures tend to heal within six to eight weeks.
